Up to 75% of the net revenue raised by the Richmond Affiliate through special events and the generosity of individual and corporate donors is distributed right back into the community of Central Virginia. The remaining 25% directly supports Komen's National Research Grant Program.

Since 1998, the Komen Richmond Affiliate has raised **over \$3.3 million** for both local programs and Komen's National Research Grant Program. We are currently funding 15 innovative projects totaling **\$556,910**.
